



2017EMMASTADCUP

Regular Season

All matches played during the year up until the The Finale on November 25, 2017 with the exception of Two-men Best Ball, Open Tournaments, Charity Tournaments and Side-matches to Cup Tournaments, will award Emmastad Cup points.

The winners of regular matches will be awarded 500 points while the winners of the four Majors (Zingel Cup, Club Championship – total net score, Vlaggen Cup and Studio Acht Cup) will be awarded 600 points.

Up until the final four Emmastad Cup events of the year, called the Regular Season, all players will be eligible to earn EC points. After the Regular Season, during the final four EC events of the year, called the Playoffs, only those players who qualify for those events will earn EC points.

PLAYOFFS

The Emmastad Cup Playoffs consist of four final Emmastad Cup matches:

- Playoff Event 1: October 7, 2017 – Monthly Medal (Low Net)
- Playoff Event 2: October 14, 2017 - Stableford
- Playoff Event 3: November 4, 2017 - Monthly Medal (Low Net)
- The Finale: November 18, 2017 – Low Net

1. The regular season standings determine the top-85 players who qualify for Event 1.
2. Event 2 will have the top-75 players from Event 1.
3. Event 3 will have the top-55 players from Event 2.
4. The finale will be comprised of the top-30 qualifiers from Event 3.

Each playoff event offers 2,000 points (quadruple the PGA TOUR Season) to the winner. The Emmastad Cup Playoffs Points can be found in the Emmastad Cup Point System document.

Following a 30-man reseed*, those players will compete for the Emmastad Cup, with one to be crowned the Emmastad Cup champion

Note: In case of ties, reseed points will be distributed between the tying positions using the same methods for dealing with ties during events -- the total points for each of the tying positions are divided equally among all players in the tying position. In the event that a



player who qualifies for a Playoff event chooses not to play in that event, there will be no alternates, and the field will be shortened. Emmastad Cup points are subject to change.

***FINAL RESEED**

At the conclusion of the Event 3, the top 30 players in the Emmastad Cup Points standings will be eligible for The Finale and will be reseeded based on their position. The reseeded points are shown in the table below. Points during The Finale are earned at the same rate they are in any other Playoffs event. Following The Finale, the total points each player earns based on his finish at The Finale will be added to his reseeded points, and the player with the highest point total will be named winner of the Emmastad Cup.

In the event of a tie in Emmastad Cup points following The Finale, the winner will be decided in a sudden-death playoff immediately following completion of competition. The sudden-death playoff will follow the same format that would be used in the event of a tie for first place at The Finale.
